
Access


It's just 17 minutes by train from Osaka-Umeda Station in central Osaka. The campus is also easy to reach from other big cities like Kyoto and Kobe.



Message from the Chairman

Founded in 1933, Osaka Seikei Gakuen has nearly 90 years of history. Our group of schools comprises Osaka Seikei University, Biwako Seikei Sport College, Osaka Seikei College, Osaka Seikei Girls' High School, and Komichi Kindergarten. We have around 7,300 students enrolled and 129.000 alumni.*

Osaka Seikei Gakuen's educational philosophy derives from a Chinese proverb recorded by Sima Qian in the ancient *Records of the Grand Historian*. The proverb states, "Peaches and plums don't speak, but people gather beneath them, drawn by their flowers and fruits. In time, a path to the trees emerges." Interpreting this allegory, we say that someone with integrity will draw others who admire their virtue.

At Osaka Seikei Gakuen, we act on the principles of *chujo* ("faithfulness and kindness"). In our actions, we follow our conscience and consider others.

To embody the educational philosophy of Osaka Seikei Gakuen, you need what we call "human qualities." These are the qualities we foster in our students:

- Being full of vitality, having a strong body and a flexible mind;
- 2. Displaying a level of reading, writing, listening, and speaking able to meet global standards;
- 3. Being able to interact well with others, but still act and think independently;
- Having sound judgement and a broad perspective for problem solving;
- Being curious, ambitious, and persistent in the face of obstacles:
- 6. Understanding others, valuing personal bonds, being loyal and kind.

In recent years, we have conducted wide-ranging educational reforms aimed at fostering lifelong learning and global competence and assuring the quality of our education for the 21st century and beyond. Faculty and staff are working on numerous projects with these goals in

mind. We have improved first-year education and career education, innovated the curricula for liberal arts and specialized subjects, and enhanced joint classes with companies and local governments. We have also introduced active learning in all classes; rather than passively watching lectures, students take the initiative in solving problems through research and discussions. We also hold contests and make students' progress more visible. In 2019 we built the Global-kan building, an English education hub for our university and college. Through English guidance and study-abroad programs, we are nurturing individuals who can be active on the world stage.

Along with these educational reforms, we have established new faculties, departments, and courses. Furthermore, to continue being a comprehensive educational institute encompassing aspects of culture, science, and art, Osaka Seikei University established the Faculty of Global Tourism and Management in 2022. We also plan to open the Faculty of Nursing Science and the Faculty of Data Science in 2023.**

Compared to 12 years ago, we have 2.3 times as many applicants and 1.6 times as many enrollees. I hope Osaka Seikei Gakuen will attract even more students in the future, and that they'll become well-respected individuals who use the knowledge and expertise they gain here to serve their communities and organizations.

Osaka Seikei University



Founded in 2003, the University comprises four faculties: Faculty of Management, Faculty of Arts, Faculty of Education, and Faculty of Global Tourism and Management. Our education emphasizes project-based

Biwako Seikei **Sport College**



This college was founded in 2003. Our six courses provide multifaceted learning of sports, such as Physical Education and Lifelong Sports. Our campus is set in the natural surroundings of Lake Biwa and the Hira Mountains.

Osaka Seikei Osaka Seikei College Gakuen



Since our founding in 1951, we have grown to be one of Japan's largest comprehensive junior colleges. Our seven faculties include Preschool Education, Tourism, and Cookery and Confectionery. So far, we have turned out approximately 70,000 graduates.

Osaka Seikei Girls' High School



Originating from a girls' school founded in 1933, we offer seven courses in two departments. Our focus is on career education and global education.

Komichi Kindergarten



Founded in 1952. Education here incorporates the results of preschool education research conducted at Osaka Seikei University and Osaka Seikei College.


Convenient, Vibrant Location

It is easy to get to and from, with a network of nearby train lines offering convenient access to major stations like Osaka Station and Kyoto Station. There are numerous other universities not far away, so the area and its environs are home to a vibrant youth culture that includes many overseas students. Furthermore, Osaka Seikei Gakuen enjoys close ties to local governments in Osaka, Kyoto, and other cities, and companies in the region, so students often visit these partners as part of their locally themed class assignments. Osaka Seikei Gakuen also strives to be a good citizen by holding community exchange events and lectures open to the public.

Faculty of Management

- Department of Management
- Department of Sports Management

Students learn about the resources of business management—people, goods, money, information—and how these interconnect. The most important thing in business is to collaborate with others to create new value. Students grow into individuals capable of creating such new value by studying how management can successfully solve the problems of companies and organizations.



Features of the Faculty

- Students conduct a range of project-based learning in unison with companies and local governments.
- Students present their learning achievements outside the university; for example, at competitions and academic conferences.
- Company internships and other firsthand off-campus learning experiences foster student growth.
- Students get a wide variety of study related to the SDGs.





Department of Management

Management Course

Students learn modules including product development, marketing, and management strategy that can then be applied to a wide range of industries, to help them examine social needs and also to develop ideas and problem-solving skills to boost corporate growth.



Public Management Course

A course for national and local civil servants, police officers, and firefighters. It teaches all the requisite knowledge of how national and local governments operate and nurtures candidates capable of planning and implementing measures to counter various problems such as the declining/aging population, income inequality, disasters, and environmental issues.



Food Business Course

Students learn three core areas of the food industry: management, informatics, and food science. They team up with companies and local governments to tackle product development, sales promotion, and store management techniques, honing their ability to spark joy and enrich lives through food and cuisine.



Department of Sports Management

Amidst the recent holding of major sporting events and a growing awareness of health and fitness, the sports industry looks set to catalyze the Japanese economy going forward. In this department, we teach marketing and promotion strategies tailored for the sports industry and nurture candidates well-placed to contribute to the same.

Faculty of Global Tourism and Management

Department of Global Tourism and Management

Students acquire a range of knowledge needed to work in the tourism industry and the service industry either locally or globally. They will learn how to forecast trends, communicate so as to inspire people, gain the skills to create high-value-added international travel business plans and solve problems, and acquire the second-language and communication skills to become culturally sophisticated.



Features of the Faculty

- Students get two opportunities to study overseas, take English classes geared to their level, and aim for a TOEIC score of 750 in their fourth year.
- Thanks to collaboration with the World Tourism Organization (UNWTO), classes deepen students' understanding of global trends in the tourism industry.
- Studies leverage the university's relations with private and government organizations: the UNWTO and its Japan office, ANA Strategic Research Institute, JTB, ANA Airline School, and municipal governments (Ikeda, Ibaraki, Sakai, Toyonaka, Sanda, etc.).
- In relatively newly developed areas of tourism such as ecotourism, adventure tourism, and sustainable tourism, students do fieldwork and projects in which they practice promoting local tourism and creating new kinds of tourism businesses.





• Influential guest lecturers, including former UN ambassadors and heads of airline company research institutes, teach about the latest in the tourism industry.

Department of Global Tourism and Management

Global Business Course

This is for students who want to conduct business overseas or other work related to international exchange or multinational organizations. Through studies that involve global industries and exchange with people and institutes from around the world, students will graduate with a global perspective and the ability to work on the international stage.



Global Tourism Course

This course is for students aiming to work in tourism. Through firsthand practice in taking a hospitality mindset in travel, airline, hotel, and event situations, they will learn everything they need to have the key skills to be a member of the future tourism industry.



Tourism and Community Development Course

This course is for students who want to work in regional tourism policy or tourism promotion. If you are interested in making tourism policy proposals, discovering tourism resources, and revitalizing communities through tourism, or being a part of regional promotion and community development, this course is for you.







Faculty of Education

- Division of Secondary School Education
- Division of Primary School Education

The Faculty of Education stresses thorough, real-life practice. We develop teachers who can educate and care for students and children through a tireless passion for education, a close attachment to those they teach, and the ability to put training to practical use. The curriculum gives them practical lessons and valuable in-school practicums, and it reflects the needs of today's schools. We also give students practice towards passing the teachers' certification exam before they graduate, and we offer support in finding a teaching job after graduation.



Features of the Faculty

- A high percentage of students pass the teachers' certification exam, and in the five years since the faculty was established all of our graduates have found employment (graduates from 2018 to 2022).
- Students can choose from five kinds of teaching licenses depending on their desire to work at a kindergarten, elementary school, junior/senior high school, or special-needs school.
- Students do their second-year experience and thirdand fourth-year practicum (three years total) at the same kindergarten or school, giving them more thorough on-site training.
- Students get a wealth of experience in on-site training, as well as guidance from instructors with experience on education committees and in academic societies.





Division of Secondary School Education

English Education Course

English language education has never been more important than now, in today's increasingly globalized world. This course is intended for future English teachers and designed to enhance their ability to teach in English. Students benefit from time spent in overseas educational institutions, including the U.S. and Australia, to refine their international perspective as educators.



Health and Physical Education Course

This course helps students gain the skills required for practical instruction with athletics and ball games and understand sports medical science, preventive medicine, competitive characteristics, and physical well-being. It trains teachers with the right scientific grounding for PE classes and club guidance.



Division of Primary School Education

Elementary Education Course

Based on the content of elementary school education, students learn educational theory and gain the teaching and class management skills required through numerous trial lessons and on-site training to create lessons that are as appealing as possible to children.



Preschool Education Course

Students gain insights into infant development and psychology and develop a range of childcare techniques, including music, art, and exercise. They are trained as kindergarten or nursery school teachers to support the mental and physical development of children.



Graduate School

Master's Program in Education, Graduate School of Education

Students collaborate with local schools, nurseries, and other entities involved in educating children while reflecting on a range of educational practices. We train advanced education professionals who can solve problems creatively. We have established a system for teachers already employed to learn while continuing their careers.



Faculty of Arts


Department of Art and Design

Students can achieve their dreams in any of eight courses in the Faculty of Arts. They will pursue art in a field of interest and then use what they learn upon graduation. Besides acquiring highly specialized skills, students grow into well-rounded individuals. We encourage students to think of the role art and design can play in society and mold them into people who can turn possibilities into realities.



Features of the Faculty

- Students get education in state-of-the-art design.
- In industry-government-academia project exercises, students work in teams at companies and local governments to practice using art to solve social issues.
- We hold public exhibitions where students show their work, including a third-year exhibition, a graduate exhibition, and a fashion show.
- Internships at design firms and ad agencies give students a chance early on to experience the creativity industry.
- Career counseling and job placement support help students get on their desired path.



Department of Art and Design


Manga and Digital Arts Course

Here, students gain a broad insight into manga, cover art, illustrations, and more from top professionals. Cutting-edge digital tools are used to hone techniques, and students develop their imagination to create new stories and characters.



Animation and Character Design Course

This course uses a range of media—anime, games, smartphone apps—to help students gain expressive skills and develop the key skills needed by animators and character designers. They master video-processing applications and 3D CG software operations and develop work





Game and Application Course

Students learn how to design game graphics and gain repeated production experience. They get active guidance directly from game-makers themselves in an optimal and up-to-date learning environment. We use virtual reality and the very latest in game

engines, including Unreal Engine 4.



Online Contents Design Course

Students in this course aim to become content creators for social media platforms like YouTube and Instagram. In addition to learning the video and audio skills, and developing the imaginative story-telling capabilities, needed for shooting, editing, and streaming

media, students brush up their powers of expression in voice acting and narration, in the process growing into individuals who can start new trends in online media and create new markets.



Graphic Design Course

Students learn the graphic design needed to work at ad agencies, design firms, publishers, and printers, as well as acquire skills in the fields of web applications and UI/UX (user interface/user experience) design. Students' practical learning

includes creating branding and planning events in collaboration with companies and local governments, and putting out works of design.



Illustration and Fine Arts Course

Students acquire the skills of drawing and sculpting—the bases of all forms of expression—in addition to learning how to put these to practical use. The curriculum is aimed at giving students thorough power of expression; molding them into creators who

can hold their own in the working world while also cultivating their individuality.



Fashion and Costume Design Course

This course fosters the ability to use one's original ideas and power of expression to create costumes that are in demand. Students get a broad range of study in the knowledge and skills needed in the fashion and costume design industries, such as

the workings of the fashion industry, and its logistics and quality control, trend forecasting, pattern making, sewing, and textile design.



Interior and Product Design Course

This course addresses accessories, furniture, public facilities, housing, and other lifestyle elements to nurture design professionals. This involves exploring materials such as wood, metal and fiber, learning about planes, solids, color composition

and computer technology, and refining design ability from a user's perspective.





Faculty of Data Science

■ Department of Data Science

The Faculty of Data Science turns out data science experts who use this discipline to solve existing problems and identify new ones in order to contribute to the future of society. To this end, students acquire knowledge and skill in properly handling data, understand scientific methods, and gain the analytical and intellectual abilities to discover new knowledge and value in data. They learn to use data to solve society's and organizations' problems by developing their powers of creativity and execution, communicative abilities, and teamwork, and by learning to use data ethically.



Features of the Faculty

- The curriculum steadily builds up students' knowledge and skills in everything from the basics to the application of AI and data science.
- Students take part in project-centered classes and joint research through association with companies and local governments.
- Instructors include leading data scientists from national and public universities and major corporations in the Kyoto-Osaka-Kobe area.
- We offer state-of-the-art data facilities and an ITC environment.

Faculty of Nursing Science (tentative name)

■ Department of Nursing Science

The Faculty of Nursing Science turns out nurses and public health nurses capable of solving a diverse range of healthcare issues. Students acquire the knowledge and skills nurses need and the human qualities that will make them trusted by patients and their families. They hone their powers of execution through practicums at the university's partner institutes, in the process growing into individuals capable of dealing with community residents' health issues and contributing to longer and healthier lifespans.



Features of the Faculty

- Students polish practical skills through practicums at partners such as university-affiliated hospitals, community general support centers, and home-visit nursing services.
- Through interactions with a wide range of healthcare professionals—including doctors, nurses, public health nurses, registered dieticians, pharmacists, dental hygienists, and certified care workers—students deepen understanding of community general care systems that meet diverse healthcare and nursing needs.
- In addition to specialized nursing knowledge, students gain a well-rounded education, an ethical viewpoint, and communication skills.
- Students are thoroughly prepared for national qualification exams.

Faculty of Preschool Education

We train students to become nursery or kindergarten teachers who can support the individual development of each child. Through practical training, students build their understanding of children's physical and mental growth. They study the theory of education, childcare, and welfare. They also acquire the skills needed for giving classes in art, physical education, and music—with a special focus on the piano.



Features of the Faculty

- Under the guidance of instructors with real teaching experience, students take a balanced curriculum of lectures and practice.
- The college has close relationships with partner institutes where students get strong support in their practicums.
- There are 115 pianos for use, and students get tailored individual instruction whether they are beginners or advanced.





Faculty of Nutrition

As the developed world deals with aging populations and increases in lifestyle diseases, there is growing interest in diet and health. Dieticians and school nutritionists have an important role to play. Students prepare large-scale meals and perform dietetics experiments to gain the necessary skills and knowledge.





Features of the Faculty

- Students hone their powers of execution under the guidance of working dieticians at institutes such as elementary schools and welfare facilities.
- More than 80% of graduates go on to work as dieticians.
- Students obtain a dietician's license upon graduation, and they can also aim for a registered dietician's license.







Faculty of Cookery and Confectionery

Students undergo specialized learning in three food-related courses. Under the guidance of instructors widely experienced in the field and utilizing the college's wealth of equipment, they improve their skills on the way to finding employment in a range of sectors and jobs. They can also obtain a national license; for example, as a cook or in confectionary hygiene. There are also numerous opportunities, such as contests and graduate cooking/baking exhibits, for students to display the fruits of their study.



















Cookery Course

Students learn to prepare various cuisines, including Japanese, Western, and Chinese. Upon graduation, they

acquire a national license as a cook. Students are also taught professional etiquette and other relevant knowledge.



Confectionery Course

Of course confectionery should look and taste good; but it should also be safe to eat. Students in this course acquire

confectionery-making skills and knowledge of food hygiene. They can also obtain a license in confectionery hygiene.



Food Coordinate Course

Students learn about the food business through themes such as cookery, confectionery, menu development, customer

service, and interior design of eating spaces. Etiquette education and on-site training at hotels help students acquire a hospitality mindset.





Faculty of Apparel Design

There are two courses in apparel and fashion. Full-fledged fashion shows are held so students can experience the entire range of work in the apparel and fashion industry. With the college being one of the few in Japan offering training for a second-grade textiles advisor license, students can aim for a variety of qualifications in apparel and fashion.



Apparel and Stylist Course

By studying textiles, sewing, and design, students gain specialized knowledge of apparel, the foundation of

fashion. They express their creativity through original clothing designs that are unveiled at a fashion show.



Fashion Coordinate Course

Students are trained to become fashion coordinators by learning about product planning, sales promotions, and color coordination. They also

color coordination. They also sharpen their ability to pick fashion trends.













Faculty of Tourism

This faculty was established in 1967, and at the time we were the only comprehensive junior college in Japan with a faculty of tourism. Students research tourism through data analysis and fieldwork. They learn useful industry skills, such as how to operate an airline reservation system. They take part in on-site training at hotels and airports. And they learn about other hospitality businesses, such as the wedding industry.





Features of the Faculty

- Full support is offered in obtaining tourism-related licenses; for example, through the national exam for certified domestic travel supervisor and the hotel management proficiency exam.
- Students receive practical guidance by instructors with a wide range of real-life experience.
- Instruction by native speakers in language classes and overseas study ensure deeper understanding of foreign cultures.





Faculty of Business Management and Accounting

Students choose from two courses to match their desired career path. They acquire practical skills that can be immediately put to use in business situations and the medical field. They also get a full range of support in obtaining practical qualifications and certifications they can use in their future jobs.



Business Management and Accounting Course

Students obtain skills in bookkeeping, accounting, information processing, and customer service. By developing their business etiquette and presentation skills, they learn how to conduct business smoothly in various industries. Classes are also given by practicing certified accountants and tax attorneys.





Medical Clerk Course

This course turns out graduates who can conduct clerical duties throughout the medical field. The curriculum prepares them for official certification exams that qualify them for a variety of hospital clerical work. Besides certification for general medical clerical duties, students can aim to be a nurse's aide, a qualification in increasingly high demand that provides support in patient care and services.



Faculty of Global Communication

Students develop their confidence through electives covering Japanese presentation, English conversation, voice acting, or stage performance. Along with full-time language teachers, the faculty employs a professional voice actor and a former Takarazuka Revue actress.

Sport and Physical Education Course

We nurture students who can help improve health, physical education, and sports activities in schools by repeating trial lessons, cultivating teaching skills, and encouraging reflection. They learn the essence of teaching through practice and volunteering in school.

Sport Business Course

Whether engaging in sport or just watching it, we teach all aspects of sports management. This wide-ranging course encompasses professional sports management, consumption behavior in sports and leisure, and sports facilities management, among others.

Health and Training Science Course
